आदर्श व्यक्तित्व के स्वामी 'भारत रत्न' श्री अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी

राष्ट्रीय क्षितिज पर स्वच्छ छवि के साथ अजातशत्रु कहे जाने वाले कवि एवं पत्रकार, सरस्वती पुत्र अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी, एक व्यक्ति का नाम नहीं है वरन् वो तो राष्ट्रीय विचारधारा का नाम है। राष्ट्रहित एवं राष्ट्रभाषा हिन्दी के प्रबल पक्षधर अटल जी राजनेताओं में नैतिकता के प्रतीक हैं।

अटल जी का जन्म 25 दिसम्बर 1924 को ब्रह्ममुहूर्त में ग्वालियर में हुआ था। मान्यता अनुसार पुत्र होने की खुशी में जहाँ घर में फूल की थाली बजाई जा रही थी तो वहीं पास के गिरजाघर में घंटियों और तोपों की आवाज के साथ प्रभु ईसामसीह का जन्मदिन मनाया जा रहा था। शिशु का नाम बाबा श्यामलाल वाजपेयी ने अटल रखा था। माता कृष्णादेवी दुलार से उन्हें अटल्ला कहकर पुकारती थीं। पिता का नाम पं. कृष्ण बिहारी वाजपेयी था। वे हिन्दी, संस्कृत और अंग्रेजी तीनों भाषाओं के विद्वान थे। पं. कृष्णबिहारी वाजपेयी ग्वालियर राज्य के सम्मानित कवि थे। उनके द्वारा रचित ईश प्रार्थना राज्य के सभी विद्यालयों में कराई जाती थी। जब वे अध्यापक थे तो डॉ. शिवमंगल सिंह सुमन उनके शिष्य थे। ये कहना अतिशयोक्ति न होगी कि अटल जी को कवि रूप विरासत में मिला है।

अटल जी की शिक्षा-दीक्षा ग्वालियर में ही सम्पन्न हुई। 1939 में जब वे ग्वालियर के विक्टोरिया कॉलेज में अध्ययन कर रहे थे तभी से राष्ट्रीय स्वयं संघ में जाने लगे थे। अपने मित्र श्री खानवलकर के साथ प्रत्येक रविवार को आर्यकुमार सभा के कार्यक्रमों में भाग लेते थे। वहीं उनकी मुलाकात शाखा के प्रचारक नारायण जी से हुई। अटल जी उनसे बहुत प्रभावित हुए और रोज शाखा जाने लगे। 1942 में लखनऊ शिविर में अटल जी ने अपनी कविता हिन्दू तन-मन, हिन्दू जीवन, जिस ओजस्वी और तेजस्वी शैली में पढ़ी थी उसकी चर्चा लोग आज भी करते हैं। तब कौन जानता था कि अटल जी एक दिन भारत के प्रधानमंत्री बनेंगे।

राष्ट्र के उच्चकोटी के वक्ता अटल जी का भाषण सुनने के लिए दूर-दूर से लोग आते थे। उनका भाषण उनकी पहचान है। भाषण के बीच में व्यंग्य विनोद की फुलझड़ियाँ श्रोताओं के मन में कभी मीठी गुदगुदी उत्पन्न करती है, तो कभी ठहाकों के साथ हंसा देती है। अपने पहले भाषण का जिक्र करते हुए अटल जी कहते हैं कि

मेरा पहला भाषण जब मैं कक्षा पाँचवी में था तब रट कर बोलने गया था और मैं बोलने में अटक रहा था, मेरी खूब हँसाई हुई थी। तभी से मैंने संकल्प लिया था कि रट कर भाषण नहीं दुंगा। अपनी उच्चकोटी की भाषण प्रतिभा से वे कई बार वाद-विवाद प्रतियोगिता में विजयी रहे।

अटल जी स्वादिष्ट भोजन के प्रेमी हैं। मिठाई तो उनकी कमजोरी रही है। काशी से जब चेतना दैनिक का प्रकाशन हुआ तो अटल जी उसके संपादक नियुक्त किये गये। शाम को प्रेस से लौटते समय राम-भंडार नामक मिठाई की दुकान पडती थी। उस दुकान के मीठे परवल सभी को बहुत पसंद थे। अटल जी को तो बहुत पसंद थे किन्तु उस समय इतने पैसे नहीं हुआ करते थे कि रोज खाया जाए, तो दुकान से कुछ पहले ही कहने लगते थे कि आँखें बन्द करलो वरना ये परवल सामने आकर बड़ी पीडा देंगे। उनकी इस विनोद भरी बातों से सभी हँसने लगते थे। उनका ये विनोदी स्वभाव विपरीत परिस्थिति में उन्हें सहज रखता है।

उन्होंने लम्बे समय तक राष्ट्रधर्म, पांचजन्य और वीर अर्जुन आदि राष्ट्रीय भावना से ओत-प्रोत अनेक पत्र-पत्रिकाओं का सम्पादन भी किया। ये निर्विवाद सत्य है, कि अटल जी नैतिकता का पर्याय हैं। पहले कवि और साहित्यकार तदपश्चात् राजनीतिज्ञ हैं। उनकी इंसानियत कवि मन की कायल है। नैतिकता को सर्वोपरि मानने वाले अटल जी कहते हैं कि—

छोटे मन से कोई बड़ा नहीं होता,

टूटे मन से कोई खड़ा नहीं होता।

मन हार कर मैदान नहीं जीते जाते,

न मैदान जीतने से मन ही जीता जाता है।

अटल जी एक सच्चे इंसान और लोकप्रिय जननायक हैं। वसुधैव कुटुम्बकम् की भावना से परिपूर्ण, सत्यम-शिवम-सुन्दरम् के पक्षधर अटल जी का सक्रिय राजनीति में पदार्पण 1955 में हुआ था। जबकि वे देशप्रेम की अलख को जागृत करते हुए 1942 में ही जेल गए थे। सादा जीवन उच्च विचार वाले अटल जी अपनी सत्यनिष्ठा एवं नैतिकता की वजह से अपने विरोधियों में भी अत्यन्त लोकप्रिय रहे हैं। 1994 में उन्हें 'सर्वश्रेष्ठ सांसद' एवं 1998 में

‘सबसे ईमानदार व्यक्ति’ के रूप में सम्मानित किया गया है। 1992 में “पद्मविभूषण” जैसी बड़ी उपाधी से अलंकृत अटल जी को 1992 में ही ‘हिन्दी गौरव’ के सम्मान से सम्मानित किया गया है। अटल जी ही पहले विदेश मंत्री थे जिन्होंने संयुक्त राष्ट्र संघ में हिन्दी में भाषण देकर भारत को गौरवान्वित किया था और राष्ट्रीय भाषा हिन्दी का मान बढ़ाया। अपनी कविता के माध्यम से कहते हैं :

गूँजी हिन्दी विश्व में,
स्वप्न हुआ साकार।
राष्ट्र संघ के मंच से,
हिन्दी का जयकार।
हिन्दी का जयकार,
हिन्द हिन्दी में बोला।
देख स्वभाषा प्रेम,
विश्व अचरज से डोला।

वे भारतीय जनसंघ की स्थापना करने वालों में से एक हैं और 1968 से 1973 तक उसके अध्यक्ष भी रहे। उन्होंने अपना जीवन राष्ट्रीय स्वयंसेवक संघ के प्रचारक के रूप में आजीवन अविवाहित रहने का संकल्प लेकर प्रारम्भ किया था और उस संकल्प को पूरी निष्ठा से आज तक निभाया।

सन् 1955 में उन्होंने पहली बार लोकसभा चुनाव लड़ा, परन्तु सफलता नहीं मिली। लेकिन उन्होंने हिम्मत नहीं हारी और सन् 1957 में बलरामपुर (उत्तर प्रदेश) से जनसंघ के प्रत्याशी के रूप में विजयी होकर लोकसभा में पहुँचे। सन् 1957 से 1977 तक जनता पार्टी की स्थापना तक वे बीस वर्ष तक लगातार जनसंघ के संसदीय दल के नेता रहे। मोरारजी देसाई की सरकार में सन् 1977 से 1979 तक विदेश मंत्री रहे और विदेशों में भारत की छवि को निखारा। लोकतन्त्र के सजग प्रहरी अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी ने सन् 1997 में प्रधानमंत्री के रूप में देश की बागडोर संभाली। 19 अप्रैल, 1998 को पुनः प्रधानमंत्री पद की शपथ ली और उनके नेतृत्व में 13 दलों की गठबन्धन सरकार ने पाँच वर्षों में देश के

अन्दर प्रगति के अनेक आयाम छुए। वाजपेयी राष्ट्रीय जनतांत्रिक गठबंधन सरकार के पहले प्रधानमंत्री थे जिन्होंने गैर काँग्रेसी प्रधानमंत्री पद के 5 साल बिना किसी समस्या के पूरे किए। उन्होंने 24 दलों के गठबंधन से सरकार बनाई थी जिसमें 81 मंत्री थे। कभी किसी दल ने आनाकानी नहीं की। इससे उनकी नेतृत्व क्षमता का पता चलता है। वर्तमान युग में भगवद्गीता की पंक्तियों का अनुसरण करके चल रहे हैं—कर्मण्यवाधिकारस्ते मा फलेषु कदाचनः परमाणु शक्ति सम्पन्न देशों की संभावित नाराजगी से विचलित हुए बिना उन्होंने अग्नि—दो और परमाणु परीक्षण कर देश की सुरक्षा के लिये साहसी कदम भी उठाये। सन 1998 में राजस्थान के पोखरण में भारत का द्वितीय परमाणु परीक्षण किया जिसे अमेरिका की सी०आई०ए० को भनक तक नहीं लगने दी।

अटल जी नेहरू युगीन संसदीय गरिमा के स्तंभ हैं। आज अटल जी करोड़ों लोगों के लिए विश्वसनियता तथा सहिष्णुता के प्रतीक हैं। जननायक अटल जी का उदार मन, आज की गला काट संस्कृति से परे सदैव यही कामना करता है कि :—

मेरे प्रभु,
मुझे कभी इतनी ऊँचाई मत देना,
गैरों को गले न लगा सकूँ,
इतनी रुखाई कभी मत देना।

राष्ट्रपति श्री प्रणब मुखर्जी ने पूर्व प्रधानमंत्री श्री अटल बिहारी वाजपेयी को उनके उत्कृष्ट कार्यों के लिए 27 मार्च 2015 को उनके निवास स्थान पर जाकर भारत के सर्वोच्च नागरिक सम्मान “भारत रत्न” से सम्मानित किया।

आत्मियता की भावना से ओत—प्रोत, विज्ञान की भी जय जयकार करने वाले, लोकतंत्र के सजग प्रहरी, राजनीति के मसीहा अटल जी को ईश्वर स्वस्थ दीर्घायु प्रदान करे यही प्रार्थना करते हैं और 25 दिसंबर को आने वाले उनके अगले जन्मदिन पर उनका अभिनन्दन एवं वंदन करते हैं।

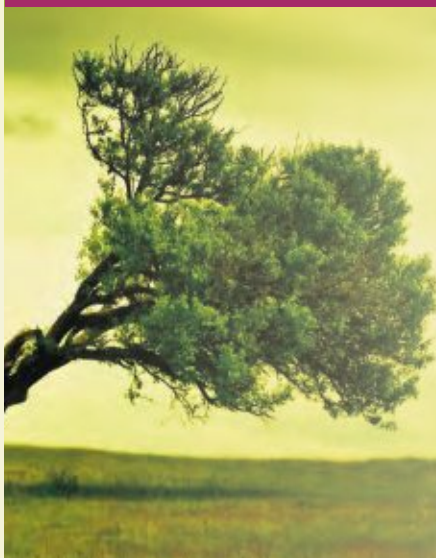

Parenting an Indian Parent

Parenting is one job that never takes a break and does not go for vacation any time which means that the responsibilities of parents never take a back seat and concerns increase by the passage of time. Even a child grows into adulthood, the grooming sessions by parents unceasingly take place regularly. In fact the challenges and struggles of an Indian parent speak volumes about his commitment to building a good life for his children and family.

In modern times when there is a lot of influence of media and gadgets on a child, raising children certainly has become more challenging and tedious at times. The problems that a parent had during his childhood have become irrelevant today and the challenges of dealing with kids are sometimes unfamiliar to them. The job can get easier, though, when you learn new parenting skills and reach out for support. Being the Principal of a Residential School and out of my experience in dealing the children, here are a few tools of assistance that may help you in parenting a child:

- Control what you can: your response:** Don't let your emotions get the better of you by responding with humble approach, showcasing your helplessness. You will have to be consistent and confirmed about hiding your emotional virtues and show the committed feelings of determination. Being steady, measured and predictable will work even if your child is not demonstrating his or her discomfort in a visible manner. Stay focused on what you do have control over: your response. The wonderful thing about being confident in this process is that you can stay calm and manage your approach maintaining a proper balance between comforts and commitments.
- Walking away is often the best response in some of the moments:** It is seen that in some situations often the best way would be setting the limit and walking away. This means not engaging in a power struggle with your child. When you respond this way, you are showing your child you will no longer reinforce negative behavior. By taking some time to cool down and allowing your child to do the same, you are increasing the chance that you will be able to have a calm conversation with your child that's more effective and productive.
- Tackle one behavior or issue at a time:** When I have an interaction with parents in my office I generally see that they often focus on several issues at once. This shows that they are very concern about the development of their ward. Such reasons are valid for parents to step in and teach their kids how to meet their responsibilities respectfully and on time. But trying to take up all issues at once is not an effective way of bringing about any change in a child. Most parents and kids just become too overwhelmed with the pressure to

improve every part of their lives at once. Giving yourself permission to slow down and focus on a plan to help your child practice better behavior will be more effective in the long run. It will give the parent and the child a chance to stay grounded and clear about expectations and limits at home and school.

- Be role model of the behavior you want to see:** Role modeling is a powerful way to influence good behavior. It's true that kids *watch* what the parents *do* more than they *listen* to what they *say*. If you practise a consistent method of teaching and coaching your child with clear limits, expectations and appropriate consequences and rewards, then you're providing them with the opportunity to solve their problems more successfully. The parents must remember that their job as a parent is to provide them with the tools and opportunities to be successful by keeping their behavior proper.
 - Aim for "good enough," not "perfect.":** Too often we look to those around us and compare our lives, our kids, and our parenting to what we see others doing. We often find ourselves coming up short as compared to the lives we believe other people are living. We must remember that everyone does the best one can, including you. Being human, it is not possible to do everything perfectly all the time. The parents must understand that their child is doing the best he can. At a young age, he doesn't have the skills and strategies to manage the feelings that come along with being human. We're all just doing our best to navigate through life. The more we remember this, the more it can help us to have empathy when your child is struggling. So let your child do the best he can.
 - Have patience. Behavior change is a process, not an event:** Just like behaviors are learned and developed over time, so does changing those behaviors and learning new ways to solve problems take time. It is important to remember that creating change first starts with the parent. The more consistent and repetitive you are in addressing your child's behavior and choices, the more likely you are to create effective change for the long term. Be patient; change will happen if you stick with it.
- Finally, I would suggest sincerely that the parents must take some time right now, before moving on with their hectic day, acknowledge all the work that your child does and give him enough space to breathe. You must know that there are other parents just like you working right alongside you. It helps, when you are struggling with your most challenging parenting issues, to know that you are not in this alone. All the parents in India even globally have the same issues. We must patiently support the child and understand his behavioral needs.

पं. तुलसीराम जी : एक परिचय

एक व्यक्ति ही नहीं, चलती-फिरती समाज सेवी संस्था थे

भूख, प्यास से दम तोड़ते पशु हो या अकाल की चपेट में मानव अथवा जन साधारण को स्वास्थ्य सेवाएं सुलभ करानी हो या शिक्षा। सभी प्रकार के सामाजिक कार्यों में बढ़-चढ़कर भाग लेते हुए अपना सम्पूर्ण जीवन समाज सेवा को समर्पित कर देने वाले लोहारू उपमंडल कस्बा बहल के आजीवन सरपंच रहे मास्टर तुलसीराम जी 26 जुलाई 1991 अपनी जीवन यात्रा पूरी कर चुके, लेकिन इनके द्वारा किए गए सामाजिक कार्यों को आज भी सम्मान के साथ याद किया जाता है।



मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी

मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी का जन्म एक ब्राह्मण परिवार में लोहारू उपमंडल के गांव मंडोली-लाखलाणा में सन् 1918 में हुआ।

मास्टर जी के पिता श्री दुर्गा प्रसाद जी इन दिनों मंडोली गांव के पटवारी पद पर कार्यरत थे। मास्टर जी का सही मायने में लालन पालन इनकी बहन रमा देवी ने किया। मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी ने अपनी प्राथमिक शिक्षा बहल में प्राप्त की और बाद में पिलानी (राजस्थान) में शिक्षा ग्रहण करने चले गये। शिक्षा के प्रति उनका बेहद लगाव था व इनकी गिनती मेधावी छात्रों में होती थी। 1937 में बिरला कॉलेज पिलानी से इन्टरमिडिएट की परीक्षा पास की। विद्यार्थी सहायक सभा के मंत्री पद पर रहते हुए इन्होंने साहित्य विशारद की परीक्षा भी उत्तीर्ण की।

उनकी असाधारण प्रतिभा को देखते हुए उद्योगपति बिड़ला बंधुओं ने मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी को नौकरी हेतु आमन्त्रित किया। इन दिनों इस क्षेत्र में भयंकर अकाल स्थिति थी। भूख से मानव व पशु दम तोड़ रहे थे। मास्टर जी से यह देखा नहीं गया और उन्होंने नौकरी का विचार छोड़ कर सेठ रामेश्वरदास साबू की प्रेरणा से अकाल सहायता के लिए एक नवयुवक समिति का गठन किया तथा मानव सेवा में तहेदिल से लगकर सेवाभावना से अधिक रूप से समिति की स्थिति मजबूत करके अकाल पीड़ितों की खुले दिल से सहायता की। पशुओं के लिए पंजाब से चारा स्वयं खरीद लाए और भूख से मरते पशुओं को प्राणदान दिया।

इसके अलावा आसपास के गाँवों में गऊओं की दुर्दशा को देखते हुए मास्टर जी ने एक अस्थाई गऊशाला का निर्माण किया और तीन सौ से अधिक गऊओं के लिए चारे एवं पानी की व्यवस्था

की। आसपास की कमजोर गऊओं को गौशाला में शरण दी जाती थी। गऊशाला की सहायता के लिए श्री तुलसीराम जी कलकत्ता व मुम्बई गए जहाँ से धन संग्रह करके अकाल सहायता कोष द्वारा राहत कार्यों का विस्तार किया।

देश के पहले पंचायत चुनाव में मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी बहल गाँव के सरपंच निर्वाचित चुने गये। इसके पश्चात् वे प्रत्येक योजना से सरपंच पद पर चुने जाते रहे और आजीवन सरपंच रहे।

प्राणी मात्र की सेवा करना ही मास्टर जी का जीवन लक्ष्य था। मानव सेवा की भावना दिल में लगाए पं० तुलसीराम जी ने बहल कस्बे

में मानव कल्याण ट्रस्ट की स्थापना करके अस्पताल एवं प्रसूति गृह स्थापित करवाया। आज यह अस्पताल मानव कल्याण ट्रस्ट अस्पताल एवं श्रीमती जयदेवी शंकरमल साबू प्रसूति गृह के नाम से मानव सेवा में कार्यरत है। वे ट्रस्ट के धन संग्रह के लिए अनेक जगहों पर गये।

सन् 1944 में तुलसीराम जी ने जन साधारण को शिक्षा सुलभ कराने का जिम्मा उठाया और बिना किसी शुल्क के बच्चों को पढ़ाते थे। 1945 से स्कूल को उच्च विद्यालय का दर्जा मिलने पर आसपास के गाँवों के छात्रों के लिए भी शिक्षा के द्वार खुल गए। सन् 1968 में यह स्कूल राज्य सरकार के अधीन कर दिया गया।

सन् 1952 से निरन्तर सरपंच रहने वाले मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी पंचायत समिति लोहारू व सिवानी के सदस्य भी रहे। ये सिवानी सब जेल के विजिस्टर व आवास बोर्ड हरियाणा के सदस्य भी रहे।

मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी ने तीन बार राज्य विधानसभा के लिए चुनाव लड़ा परन्तु जीत उनको नसीब नहीं हुई और तीनों ही बार मामुली अन्तर से विधानसभा में प्रवेश से वंचित रहे। अपने अन्तिम चुनाव 1986 के बाद बीमार हो गए और 26 जुलाई 1991 में इस समाजसेवी ने संसार से विदाई ले ली। लोहारू में आज भी लोग मास्टर पं० तुलसीराम जी को पूर्ण सम्मान के साथ याद करते हैं।

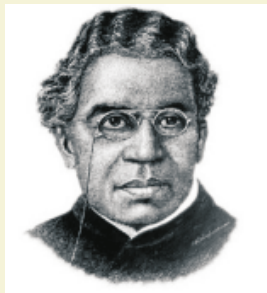

JAGDISH CHANDRA BOSE



Jagdish Chandra Bose was the first to prove that plants too have feelings. He invented wireless telegraphy a year before Marconi patented his invention. Jagdish Chandra Bose was an eminent Indian scientist. He was the first to prove that plants and metals too have feelings. Jagdish Chandra Bose was born on November 30, 1858 in Mymensingh (now in Bangladesh). His father Bhagabanchandra Bose was a Deputy Magistrate.

Jagdish Chandra Bose had his early education in village school in Bengal medium. In 1869, Jagdish Chandra Bose was sent to Calcutta to learn English and was educated at St. Xavier's School and College. He was a brilliant student. He passed the B.A. in physical sciences in 1879.

In 1880, Jagdishchandra Bose went to England. He studied medicine at London University, England, for a year but gave it up because of his own ill health. Within a year he moved to Cambridge to take up a scholarship to study Natural Science at Christ's College Cambridge. In 1885, he returned from abroad with a B.Sc. degree and Natural Science Tripos (a special course of study at Cambridge).

After his return Jagdish Chandra Bose, was offered lectureship at Presidency College, Calcutta on a salary half that of his English colleagues. He accepted the job but refused to draw his salary in protest. After three years the college ultimately conceded his demand and Jagdish Chandra Bose was paid full salary from the date he joined the college. As a teacher Jagdish Chandra Bose was very popular and engaged the interest of his students by making extensive use of scientific demonstrations. Many of his students at the Presidency College were destined to become famous in their own right. These included Satyendra Nath Bose and Meghnad Saha.

In 1894, Jagdish Chandra Bose decided to devote himself to pure research. He converted a small enclosure adjoining a bathroom in the Presidency College into a laboratory. He carried out experiments involving

refraction, diffraction and polarization. It would not be wrong to call him as the inventor of wireless telegraphy. In 1895, a year before Guglielmo Marconi patented this invention; he had demonstrated its functioning in public.

Jagdish Chandra Bose later switched from physics to the study of metals and then plants. He fabricated a highly sensitive "coherer", the device that detects radio waves. He found that the sensitivity of the coherer decreased when it was used continuously for a long period and it regained its sensitivity when he gave the device some rest. He thus concluded that metals have feelings and memory.

Jagdish Chandra Bose showed experimentally plants too have life. He invented an instrument to record the pulse of plants and connected it to a plant. The plant, with its roots, was carefully picked up and dipped up to its stem in a vessel containing bromide, a poison. The plant's pulse beat, which the instrument recorded as a steady to-and-fro movement like the pendulum of a clock, began to grow unsteady. Soon, the spot vibrated violently and then came to a sudden stop. The plant had died because of poison.

Although Jagdish Chandra Bose did invaluable work in Science, his work was recognized in the country only when the Western world recognized its importance. He founded the Bose Institute at Calcutta, devoted mainly to the study of plants. Today, the Institute carries research on other fields too.

Jagdish Chandra Bose died on November 23, 1937.

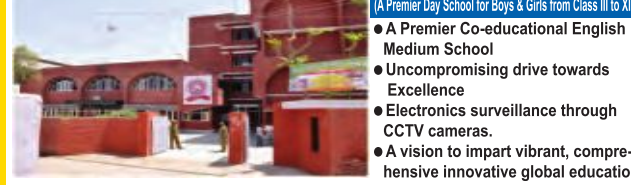
