
**Havan Pujan at BRCM Education Society's Complex**




**Philanthropy Honours 2022 to Shri Hari Krishna Chaudhary**

वर्तमान में बी.आर.सी.एम. शिक्षण संस्थान के तत्वाधान में स्कूली शिक्षा से लेकर उच्च शिक्षा के लिए शानदार शैक्षणिक संस्थाओं का संचालन हो रहा है जिनमें देश एवं प्रदेश के विभिन्न क्षेत्रों से लगभग 5000 विद्यार्थी शिक्षा से लाभान्वित हो रहे हैं। इसके साथ-साथ गरीब बच्चों के उत्थान के लिए 'नन्हे कदम' स्कूल के माध्यम से निःशुल्क शिक्षा प्रदान किया जा रहा है जिसका लाभ लगभग 200- 300 छात्र उठा रहे हैं। न केवल शिक्षा अपितु पूरे क्षेत्र के सर्वांगीण विकास को ध्यान में रखते हुए संस्था जन-कल्याण के लिए अनेक सरकारी एवं गैर-सरकारी महत्वपूर्ण योजनाएं क्रियान्वित कर रही है। आस-पास के ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में स्वास्थ्य सुविधाओं की कमी को ध्यान में रखते हुए सन् 2006 में मानव कल्याण अस्पताल का जीर्णोद्धार कर गरीब एवं लाचार लोगों का आधुनिक तकनीक से युक्त सभी रोगों का न केवल उपचार किया जा रहा है बल्कि यहां प्रति सप्ताह नेत्र विशेषज्ञों द्वारा आंखों की जांच व ऑपरेशन भी किए जा रहे हैं। इसके साथ-साथ स्वयं सहायता समूह (एस.एच.जी.) की स्थापना के लिए नाबार्ड के साथ मिलकर ग्रामीण विकास प्रकोष्ठ के तहत 195 एस. एच. जी., 130 जे.एल.जी., एफ.पी.ओ. और किसान क्लबों का गठन कर सरकार की योजनाओं से ग्रामीणों को जोड़कर मूलभूत सुविधाएं उपलब्ध कराई जा रही हैं। इसके अलावा बी.डी.पी. के तहत 2 गांवों को गोद भी ले रखा है। बी.आर.सी.एम. स्किल डेवलपमेंट सेंटर के माध्यम से सरकारी एवं गैर सरकारी योजनाओं को कार्यान्वित करने के लिए ग्रामीण पुरुषों एवं महिलाओं को रोजगार प्रशिक्षित जैसे कि- टेलरिंग, ब्यूटी पार्लर, प्लंबर, कंप्यूटर कोर्स, कस्टमर केयर, इलेक्ट्रीशियन आदि कोर्सेज कराए जाते हैं जिससे उनकी आर्थिक स्थिति में सुधार हो और अपनी आजीविका को बेहतर रूप से चला सके।

श्री हरिक्रिशन चौधरी जी की परोपकार करने की यह इच्छा इतनी प्रबल है कि यह यूँ ही नहीं रुकने वाली है बल्कि आगे की विकास यात्रा में 'नारी उत्थान' और 'बेटी बचाओ- बेटी पढ़ाओ' जैसी योजनाओं पर कार्य करना अभी शेष है।


## Prize Giving Ceremony of 11 Haryana BN NCC, Bhiwani
