## **6. REVIEW OF PROGRESS.**

- The members were glad to note the previous five year admission status and admission status of the session 2024-25. The members were also happy to see the student's achievements, University Results, Merit Positions, Placements and Extra Curricular Activities of our students during the session 2023-24.
- The BOG members were appreciated the faculty achievements and other academic and non-academic events that were being organized in the last one year.

## **7. CLOSURE OF B.TECH (ME) PROGRAM FROM THE SESSION 2025-26.**

In the BOG meeting, the proposal to close the B.Tech (Mechanical Engineering) program from the 2025-26 session was discussed. After thorough consideration, the BOG members decided not to approve the closure, emphasizing the program's ongoing importance in core engineering sectors and the need to maintain traditional disciplines. they recommended enhancing the curriculum and implementing strategies to attract more students.

## **8. STARTING OF B.TECH CSE (AI & ML), BCA AND BBA PROGRAMS**

In the BOG meeting, the proposal to start new programs in B.Tech CSE (AI & ML), BCA, and BBA was discussed. The BOG members granted approval to start AI & ML program, recognizing its growing demand and relevance in the current job market. However, for the BCA and BBA programs, they recommended conducting a detailed review of the market demand and admission trends in to the upcoming session. B.Tech CSE (AI&ML) can be started from session 2025-26 with 60 Intake.

## **11. ANY OTHER ITEM WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR.**

The followings suggestions were came out during the discussion:

- Hon'ble Chairman suggested that the Placement Division should study the market to find out what types of engineers are in demand. Placement Office creates a clear strategy to improve student placements.
- Chairman also asked about the current demand for professionals in AI & ML fields.
- Dr. Surender Sharma recommended organizing a seminar on AI & ML to enhance the knowledge level of Students.inform and engage students and faculty.
- Chairman Shri H.K. Chaudhary proposed to set up a Research and Development (R&D) Centre at BRCM CET to promote research and innovation.
- The courses and syllabus should be updated to follow the NEP 2020 guidelines for skill enhancement.

- Dr. Surender Sharma also suggested focusing on increasing admissions from nearby areas of Rajasthan.
- The Chairman suggested asking new students about their career goals and what they expect from BRCM to better support them in achieving their aims.

The meeting was terminated with a hearty vote of thanks to the Chair.
