






Annual Cultural Fest-2025







आप चार भाइयों में से तीसरे नंबर पर थे। किंतु बाल्यावस्था में ही पिताश्री के स्वर्गवास हो जाने से परिवार पर कठिनाइयाँ आ गईं। इसके बावजूद आपने कक्षा आठवीं तक की शिक्षा गाँव के प्राइमरी एवं जूनियर हाई स्कूल से पूरी की। आप बचपन से ही मेधावी थे और अपनी मिडिल परीक्षा प्रथम श्रेणी में उत्तीर्ण की। इसके बाद आपने सानीसचंद्र महाविद्यालय, बलिया से इंटरमीडिएट भी प्रथम श्रेणी में उत्तीर्ण कर अपने परिवार का नाम रोशन किया।

देश सेवा का जज्बा दिल में लिए आपने शिक्षा बीच में ही छोड़कर सेना में भर्ती ली, किंतु अस्वस्थ होने के कारण आपको सेवा छोड़नी पड़ी। इस कठिन समय में आपके बड़े भाई स्वर्गीय रामदयाल जी, जो हरियाणा के बहल गाँव में हाई स्कूल के अध्यापक थे, आपको अपने पास बहल बुला लाए। यहीं पर स्थानीय औषधीय मतीरा के सेवन से आपका स्वास्थ्य सुधर गया और आप ऊर्जा से भर उठे। इसके बाद आपने अपने भाई के साथ अध्यापन कार्य आरंभ किया। बहल प्रवास के दौरान आपका परिचय स्वर्गीय छोगमल चौधरी जी एवं डॉ. सोहनलाल जी से हुआ। आपके ज्ञान, व्यक्तित्व और शिक्षा के प्रति लगन से वे गहराई से प्रभावित हुए और आपको विशेष मान-सम्मान देने लगे। आपने ही श्री छोगमल चौधरी जी के पुत्र-पुत्रियों को अपने बच्चों की तरह शिक्षित और संस्कारित किया। अध्यापन के साथ-साथ आपने अपना अध्ययन भी जारी रखा और विश्वविद्यालय में द्वितीय स्थान प्राप्त कर प्रभाकर की उपाधि तथा तत्पश्चात बी.ए. की परीक्षा भी उत्तीर्ण की।

सन् 1967 के आसपास बहल में राजकीय हाई स्कूल की स्थापना हुई। उसी समय आप गणित के अध्यापक के रूप में सरकारी सेवा में नियुक्त होकर महेन्द्रगढ़ चले गए। किंतु बहल और चौधरी परिवार से आपके गहरे लगाव के कारण आप शीघ्र ही वापस बहल लौट आए। धीरे-धीरे पूरा बहल आपको "गुरुजी" नाम से जानने और सम्मान देने लगा। सरकारी सेवा के साथ-साथ आपका जुड़ाव श्री हरिकृष्ण चौधरी जी से बना रहा। श्री चौधरी जी की यह गहरी इच्छा थी कि बहल और आसपास के क्षेत्र में उच्च शिक्षा की सुदृढ़ व्यवस्था हो। उनकी इस प्रेरणा और आपकी शिक्षा-निष्ठा के कारण बीआरसीएम पब्लिक स्कूल की स्थापना हुई। यह शिक्षा-वृक्ष आज पाँच शाखाओं के रूप में विकसित होकर न केवल हरियाणा बल्कि सम्पूर्ण भारत में प्रसिद्ध है।

आपकी प्रेरणा से ही विद्याग्राम जैसे आवासीय शिक्षा-परिसर की नींव पड़ी, जहाँ से विद्यार्थी उच्च शिक्षा प्राप्त कर आज प्रतिष्ठित पदों पर आसीन हैं। बढ़ती आयु और स्वास्थ्य संबंधी कठिनाइयों के कारण आप अपने जन्मस्थान जीराबस्ती लौट गए। वहाँ भी श्री हरिकृष्ण चौधरी जी और डॉ. सोहनलाल जी समय-समय पर आपसे मिलने और मार्गदर्शन लेने आते रहे। अंततः सन् 2012 में अपनी जन्मभूमि पर ही आपने अंतिम सांस ली।

आज भी बहल और संपूर्ण क्षेत्र आपको स्नेहपूर्वक "गुरुजी" के नाम से याद करता है।

धन्य है बहल की यह भूमि, जिसे आपके जैसा महान व्यक्तित्व और शिक्षाप्रेमी मार्गदर्शक मिला।




International Youth Day
